

Catcherman[™] Models Technical Data and Features

GENERAL: Spyderco's Model C17, "Catcherman" has long been on the wish-list of fishermen worldwide. Having the ability to fold gives this knife a variety of advantages. Retaining the traditional features of the CLIPIT line, this knife is sure to out perform any folding filet knife on the market.

BLADE: Hollow ground from a AUS-8A stainless steel, the blade on the C17 is thin enough (2mm) to give you the flex needed for any fileting job. Available in 75/25 PlainEdge/SpyderEdge or in the all SpyderEdge version, you can cut your way through any situation, be it a snagged line or bone. The nickel added to this particular steel makes it easy to maintain. Just give it a fresh water rinse, let it dry, add a drop of oil, and store it clipped to your vest or in a tackle box tray.

HANDLE: In keeping with Spyderco's "lightweight" models, we have fabricated the handles from tough Dupont Zytel®. This material can withstand the toughest abuse and comes with our standard volcano grip pattern. This handle provides a non-slip surface for better gripping power, and the reinforced clothing clip provides easy access.

LOCK: The H. McBurnette/Al Mar design enables the knife to be closed with one hand. The positive front lock prevents the blade from "bottoming" when in the closed position.
