


World Trade Center Rescue Fundraising Project


Time to give back.



Since the early '80s Spyderco has been making knives to specifically meet the needs of the Fire, Rescue, EMT, Paramedic, and Law Enforcement Professionals. When we heard that the cleanup crews at Ground Zero were having difficulty cutting through some of the tough materials like fiberglass Spyderco immediately sent a shipment of our Rescue model knives to assist them - but we wanted to do more.

With a great deal of help and support from the NYPD we were able to obtain steel from the World Trade Center Building #1. The crude steel that arrived in Golden was a challenge. After much deliberation and trial and error we decided to design a new Rescue style knife with an inset of the New York skyline made from the WTC steel. Working

with our Japanese vendor we designed a molded black FRN handle to incorporate the WTC-steel inlay. The remainder of the knife is made in our Golden, Colorado facility. If you'd like to read the full story, please check out our web site at www.spyderco.com.



The NYPD officers we were working with told us about Officer John D'Allara. John was a great Spyderco collector and aficionado and lost his life in Building #1. We decided to name this new knife the D'Allara Rescue in honor of Officer John D'Allara. We also decided to

introduce our new ball bearing lock and use CPMS30V steel for the blade, making the knife even more unique.

There will be only 2819 knives made with the WTC steel inlay and each will be numbered (343 of 2819, etc.). The mold will then be re-worked, replacing the skyline inlay with a Spyderco bug and will become part of our 2003 product line as the D'Allara Rescue model.

Spyderco will donate 100% of the profit from the WTC Rescue to the New York Police and Fire Widow's and Children's Benefit Fund, Inc. The price for the WTC Rescue is \$225.00 each plus \$6.95 (continental US) shipping and handling. There will be no dealer or quantity discounts.
